

ON THE ROAD—

Be on time for departure, “Fueled and Fed”

CB radio: Use channel 4, with 7 as alternate.

If you have no CB in your “A”, stay near the front of the group.

“Moderns” with us stay at the back of the pack.

If you have a seat belt, remember to buckle up.

The Tour Leader will designate a “Tail-gunner”, to troubleshoot and be sure no one is left behind.

On the road, leave room for other cars to cut through the line.

We usually drive 45 to 55 mph. (For long tours, an overdrive provides an easier ride, and saves wear and tear on the car.)

If you have a problem, pull off the road in a safe place with space for others if possible.

If you see another member in trouble, stop only if you can do so safely, and know you can be of help.

Fill up at the gas stops, utilize the “potty” stops, and eat ice cream whenever available.

If you leave the group for any reason, it is extremely important that you let the Tour Leader know.
